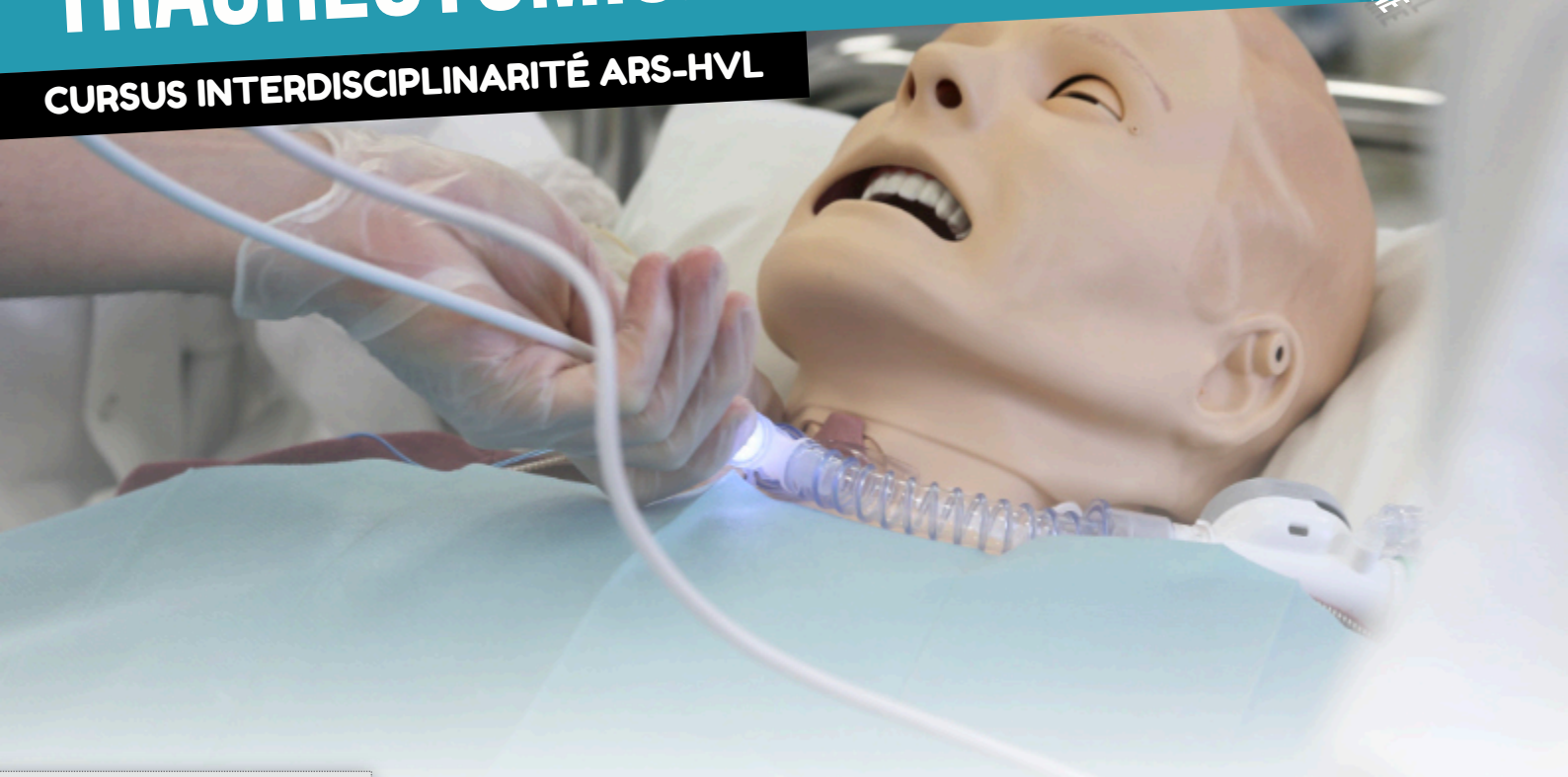

## TARGET PUBLIC

Interdisciplinary training: pulmonologists, nurses, physiotherapists, etc.

## GENERAL AND EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES

### Identifying an emergency situation:

- Analysing the clinical situation: assessing and relieving distress when treating critical situations and vital emergencies: oxygen therapy, unblocking, drainage, cannulation, etc.
- Clinical examination and analysis of vital signs, fibroscopy, etc.
- Knowing the procedures and equipment required for treatment of patients ventilated via tracheotomy tubes.

### Working in an interdisciplinary team:

Knowing how to manage an emergency situation in your field of expertise, while understanding the missions of the other professionals on the team and prioritising effective, constructive communication.

## ORGANISATION

1/2 day

**Context:** Multidisciplinary treatment of NM patients ventilated via tracheotomy in the pneumology unit (BPC4) for monitoring / control of ventilation, in intensive respiratory care.

## GROUP SIZE

Replication of a team in real situations, as closely as possible to everyday practice
